Goals of WP1

 Strengthening the content of ERSO (data and decision-support tools) by assessing the needs for knowledge-based policy-making

 Introducing a new area of knowledge into ERSO: national road safety management systems (existing situations, identification of elements of « good practice »)



Complementary approaches

- Consultation of a panel of experts on needs for data and decision-support tools for RS policy-making (common task of WP1 and WP4)
- On the same issues: large scale questionnaire survey of major RS stakeholders in the EU and associated countries (governmental actors, NGOs, businesses, researchers, professional organisations, etc.)
- Development of a methodology to describe and compare RS management systems at the national level, survey carried out in a sample of countries
- Quantitative and qualitative analyses (on-going)




COTA Consultation of a panel of experts

- EU CARE experts and other scientists (contacted: 79)
- Consultation through three broad open questions on policy-making tasks and technical needs (online and through interviews)
- A matrix crossing four key policy-making tasks (factfinding, action programme development, preparing implementation, monitoring and evaluation) and four categories of needs (data, data treatment, decisionsupport, and training tools)
- Text analysis of 30 valid answers: preliminary results on needs (for use in other WPs on « decision-support » and « data warehouse » and to develop the broader questionnaire survey of stakeholders)

1. Describing road safety management systems



- 2. Defining « good practice » criteria
- 3. Building up a semi-closed questionnaire
